
# **Trinity Road**

## **Description**


Trinity Road is a compact N Gauge layout depicting a fictitious through station and goods yard in South Manchester in the 1960s. It has been inspired by another exhibition layout (Lymebrook Yard) and also has its basis in the owner's childhood memories. The layout features what would have been recently installed 25kv overhead wires and the motive power includes a mixture of lingering steam, ubiquitous diesels and new electrics. Services are a mix of goods, parcels and local passenger traffic.

The layout is small and therefore train formations are small. There is capacity in the fiddle yard for up to 6 trains.

#### TRINITY ROAD INFORMATION SHEET

The station marks a point where double track is reduced to single with a headshunt being provided for the goods yard.
